We received a call from Deloris who is legally blind in one eye. She was unable to take care of the mowing and snow removal in her current apartment. She was approved for Section 8 new housing but needed financial assistance with the security deposit. She had saved money for the first month's rent. With the money she saved and the financial assistance she received from the Wisconsin Rapids Housing Authority, she was able to move into a new apartment.

Deloris contacted Love INC and left us a voice message. She thanked Love INC for putting in the effort to help her but she no longer needed financial assistance with the security deposit. She also asked us to give her a call and say a prayer with her because "God is good". GOD BLESS EVERYONE AT LOVE INC AND ALL THE CHURCHES. AMEN."

Deloris is correct: God is good...God is good all the time! What a great reminder.
