This Love Story is told by Executive Director,

DaNita Carlson, with excerpts from Jean Sorenson, Intake Specialist.

Mallory came to Love INC's door a number of months ago. She was from another community and was looking for a church. She thought our building still held church services. I was the only one in the office and invited her in to talk. She told me about past hurts from her home church (in the other community). I talked with her about our mission and then told her a little about each partner church to help her find one that she was comfortable with. I could tell she really needed a place to call home with people who would love her for who she was.

At some point after our conversation, Mallory called the Love INC Connection Center and was able to talk with Jean, a volunteer Intake Specialist. We were able to hear more about her story through the intake process. Jean said, "When I started my conversations with Mallory last fall, her faith in God was quickly apparent. She was struggling financially and physically, but was always grateful for God and His merciful love. She had to stop working because of physical issues and considerable pain. After months of this, she finally received a diagnosis and then surgery. Unfortunately, the surgery was not totally successful, so she had to have yet another. It had been a very long, stressful, and painful time for her; however, her faith remained steadfast. She was always so grateful for our visits, cards of encouragement, and phone calls from Love INC staff and volunteers."

In May, Mallory stopped into our office again. She had tears in her eyes and reached out her hand and gave me \$100 cash. Her voice cracked as she told me she wanted to donate to Love INC because "we were the only ones there for her when she needed someone". She continued to tell me how the calls and notes of encouragement always came at "just the right time". She added that she wanted to donate money to Love INC "so we could help others like we helped her". I asked if I could give her a hug and she said yes. We hugged in the entryway; both of us overcome with emotion.

What a blessing! Many days are challenging at Love INC. Some days it's hard to press on. Frustration and discouragement can creep in. But times like these make it all worthwhile. Mallory is worthwhile. She's worth every minute of our time.....and, so are all the neighbors! She's a child of God and deserves everything God has for her. We believed in her even when she didn't believe in herself. She needed our support and encouragement, and we were there to cheer her on.

We were asked by a local foundation president a few months ago how we know we are making a difference. Mallory is how we know. Mallory is not just a love story from "someone", but a neighbor whose life was impacted by the love, care, and compassion showed to her by our amazing staff and volunteers. Jean added this, "Making a donation with what little she has is amazing! Love her!"

Mallory's story makes me think of the story in scripture about the woman who gave two coins (Mark 12:41-44) which reads...

41 Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. 42 But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents. 43 Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. 44 They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

Project Lifesaver is a nonprofit organization that works with police departments and caregivers to place personal locator devices on the wrists or ankles of people with cognitive disorders that cause them to be prone to wander. We have been asked by Wood County Human Services and the Police Department if we would have any volunteers who would be interested in changing the batteries in the devices for some of their clients. These batteries would need to be changed once a month, and the police officer in charge of the program will provide training.
