

FIRST GAP MINISTRY





Connection Center is the The foundation of Love INC. It's where relationship building begins. Through the Connection Center, Love INC ministry volunteers receive requests for help, screen the requests for extent of need and legitimacy, and refer the requests to a local church ministry, church ministry volunteer, or community agency. When there is no way to address the need, that presents a "gap" in community resources. When enough of these are experienced a new ministry is established with partner churches to address this need.

Above right are the top twenty stated needs from client calls in 2019. As expected, the top needs are financial. However, "moving" is the fourth most requested need and there is currently no organized ministry to address this...until now. Grace Lutheran, one of our partner churches has established a new Gap Ministry to meet moving needs of Love INC clients. This will be a collaborative effort between partner churches with Grace Lutheran taking the lead. Through Love INC, Crossview, First Baptist, Port Edwards United Methodist, Faith Reformed, and Saint Lawrence have all been helping in this area. Other churches are welcome to join the team!
