CARES Act: For Churches, Non-Profits and Christian Schools

The recent CARES Act Program was signed into effect Friday. The \$2 Trillion CARES Act applies to more than individuals and small businesses. There are provisions in the Act to financially help churches, non-profits, and Christian schools that are 501C3. It provides loans to these organizations to help them through the period of time between February 15, 2020, to June 30, 2020. Realizing that these organizations may have decreased contributions, the ACT allows these organizations to loans through a local bank that potentially can be 100% forgiven – based on retaining employees. Needs Survey Results

Recently the Wood County Health Department Community Needs Task Force released their Needs Survey results. This survey was administered by the WCHD to identify local efforts and resources that are addressing rising needs in our community due to COVID-19. The summary listed below is regarding what Gaps organizations are seeing in the population they serve.

- *Food insecurities (including baby formula)
- *Lack of transportation
- *Other basic needs not being met (including: hygiene products, paper products, baby diapers/wipes, etc.)
- *Lack of cleaning supplies and sanitizers
- *Low inventory of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- *Need for childcare
- *Technical problems with distance learning and/or lack of internet access
- *Loss of wages/unemployment
- *Mental wellbeing (fear, anxiety, feeling isolated)
