The caller ID said "Love INC." Tami* thought it was telemarketer. She did not answer. (She had no idea someone put her down as a reference.) Curious, she googled Love INC and soon realized she was wrong. A couple days later, her caller ID said "Love INC" again. This time she answered. Tami had no idea how God was about to touch her world through the power of prayer.

During that call Tami shared what was going on in her life and family. It was a lot. She was stressed. She apologized at one point for going on about her own life knowing that was not the purpose of the call. But God knew what Tami needed when that call was made – prayer. She called back the next week to share the impact the prayer had on her:

"I wanted to call to let you know that last week after your prayer with me, I felt such peace. I don't know if you heard me, but I cried during the prayer. First, I felt such a relief. I have not slept sound for ages, for years. That night I slept sound. It also got me thinking how I need to get back to church. I just wanted to call to tell you, you gave me peace with your prayer."

A couple weeks later, Tami called with an update. Her great grandson was born. Her daughter had a mini stroke the same day and was hospitalized. Her mom, who was suffering from cancer and dementia, started getting worse after that day. Tami was now caring for her mother and her daughter. Tami's cares were once again taken to God in prayer.

Tami called back one last time, a week later, and shared, "Mom passed yesterday. Your prayers were answered. She really went fast. She looked so peaceful. God answered your prayers. He heard you. She got to hold her great-great grandson. I thank God for you people for praying for us and keeping us in your prayers.

Prayer isn't just for our clients. It's for everyone. The Prayer Ministry volunteers from our partner churches are daily interceding for everyone God sends our way. There is power in prayer. "Call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you." Jeremiah 29:12
