




LOVE STORY MEET DIANE

Next, Diane opted to receive calls from the Careline Gap Ministry. The purpose of the Careline is to check in with our neighbors and let them know we care about them even though their immediate need has been met. This is also when the Careline caller and the neighbor pray together. Some of our neighbors don't have friends or family who they have regular contact with. Some don't have anyone to pray with them. This isn't true for Diane. She lists her family and friends as something she is grateful for. After about a month, Diane decided that she didn't need the calls any longer.

Then, Diane heard about Love INC's new Transformational Ministry and the first class; Affirming Potential. She felt this would be a good opportunity for her and she registered right away. There was one roadblock to her attending class: transportation. One of our volunteers from Crossview Church volunteered to pick her up and bring her to class. It ended up that they were in the same discussion group and really got to know each other. God puts us with people with whom we can share, grow and pray!

Later, Diane kindly attended an ambassador breakfast and explained to the group how the Affirming Potential class impacted her. She told the group, "...as I got into it, I knew right away that I needed this class." Diane talked to us about the value of the small group discussion. She's looking forward to taking more of the Transformational Ministry classes. Now, Diane volunteers in the Love INC office. In her own words, "I want to give back to my community and help in any way I could." It's a joy and blessing to us when Diane comes in to help with administrative tasks. Thank you, Lord, for bringing Diane into our lives.


