Finding the courage to leave an abusive relationship can be very scary, especially when you fear for your safety and the safety of your two young children. That was the case for Hailey\*. The day she left, all she had was the clothes on her back, a car, and \$2.60 to her name.

Hailey and her children stayed with family friends for a month. During that time, God led Hailey to a church in Wisconsin Rapids, where she attended Sunday morning services and Bible study. God also connected Hailey with a church member who had a home available for rent. Hailey was relieved and excited to finally have a place to live, but she had no furnishings. That's when Hailey was given the number for Love INC. During the first call to Love INC, Hailey expressed concern for her family's safety and asked for prayers for God to meet their needs. What she wasn't expecting was God to provide for more than she asked for through Love INC partner and nonpartner churches, and volunteers.

Hailey was referred to Shepherd's Loft for kitchen items and to the Love INC Household Items Gap Ministry for furniture. As an extra blessing, Hailey and her children received homemade quilts and gifts for the whole family! Every item was delivered with love. Throughout the process volunteers prayed with Hailey numerous times. In a follow up call Hailey said, "The furniture is wonderful! The people were so nice! The kids are so happy! We had fun shopping at Shepherd's Loft and the gifts we received were great! Thank you!"
