Most of the people I clean for are no longer physically able to clean for themselves. They have no relatives close by to ask for help. Britt* is one of those ladies. She lives alone in a small apartment and her children live in Milwaukee. She was hungry, lonely, and craved human contact. Every other Monday, I would visit and clean her apartment. Often, I came with cake, milk, yogurt, and any kind of treat to put in her fridge. Last winter, on my visit at 1:00 pm, her door was open, and she was still in bed. She said she hadn't eaten in 3 days. She was burning up with fever. I asked her if I could pray with her. She agreed. We prayed together for her healing. I made her a chocolate shake to help with her thirst and hunger. When I discovered she couldn't even sit up, I called Love INC. It was decided to call 911, and get in contact with Britt's son.

The paramedics were there within minutes. Britt was resistant to the idea of going to the hospital. I gave her a cup of tea, and another chocolate shake. She was feeling better, but after talking with her son, he determined she needed to be seen by the ER. I stayed with her until he arrived. He was very concerned about his mother's health.

Britt was admitted with dehydration, pneumonia, and COPD. My husband & I visited her every day. After a week she suffered a heart attack. They took great care of her at the hospital! A few weeks later, she went home. Since then, her daughter moved close by, and was able to stay with Britt for a month. I still bring her yogurt and German chocolate cake. We visit, we pray together. I think people like Britt just need someone to talk to.
