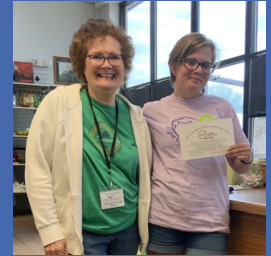


# Love In the Name of Christ of South Wood County

In the testimony, it was mentioned the dark place he had been in and the thoughts of suicide that came from being in that place.

There is no way to prepare for a random guest or to know what someone is thinking...but God can! Later, we found out that the testimony of the group leader struck the heart of the guest, who was contemplating suicide that night. Through the testimony and the combined prayers of the Wisconsin

Rapids and Bluff View CR groups, a suicide was prevented and the guest accepted Christ into his life.
