Our [New Hope Life Skills](#) classes continue to have life changing effects through the power of Christ. The class materials cover issues from setting appropriate boundaries to resolving everyday conflict. To offer these classes, we need help. Some participants need transportation to and from class or help with childcare. Does this ministry interest you?

We have a [Household Items Ministry \(HHI\)](#) which helps our neighbors with furniture and other necessities. We have generous donors that provide what we need for HHI. We are looking for church groups that can deliver these items. In that way, we can demonstrate the love and grace of God to our neighbors.

Our [Moving Ministry](#) is a team led by Grace Lutheran Church. This ministry moves people locally that cannot do it for themselves. This is a tremendous blessing to our neighbors and demonstrates our love as the hands and feet of Jesus.

Our [Backpack Ministry](#) continues to reach out to those that are being released from the Wood County Jail. Handing a formerly incarcerated person this type of care package says we care. If your heart has been wondering how to send the message, then find out how you can join us in this ministry.

Love INC is supporting the [Celebrate Recovery](#) program that meets at St. Lawrence on Tuesday evenings at 6:30pm. I have personally seen the transformational power of Christ at work in the lives of those involved. Your heart may be hungry to be a part of a team that invests in peoples broken lives.

There are other ways to invest your time and talent with Love INC, which you can find on our website. Personally, what I desire to see, is churches forming teams and assuming roles in the ministries mentioned here. In other words, a group from a church that says, "We'll provide childcare for your class." Another might say, "We can handle transportation for your next class." Still another might say, "We can deliver furniture for May and September." When our Partner Churches participate in this way, it is a public witness that they care, and a personal demonstration for those we serve.


