LOVE STORY

When someone calls the Connection Center at Love INC, we focus on the whole person, not just the need. We start by listening to their story or situation, we ask questions, get to know them, and pray with them. This approach allows us to build caring, Christ-like relationships with and reflects our mission to "mobilize local churches to transform lives and communities in the name of Christ." Jocelyn's* story is a great example of this.

While getting to know Jocelyn through a phone call in the Connection Center, we discovered that she found joy in working with children with special needs and helping others. She has a strong faith, which is very important to her. Due to health issues and lack of transportation, she required Medical Transport for medical appointments. We also learned that Jocelyn loved to swim, but again, transportation prevented her from exercising to improve her health. This emphasis on building relationships is what makes Love INC, Love INC! As we got to know her, and what was important to her, we were able to bring together staff, church partners, and volunteers to meet her needs in several ways.

- Volunteers from Love INC drive her to church weekly, and also delivered food to her from FOCUS. (The volunteer who drives her to church recently attended a get together at Jocelyn's home along with several of her friends.)
- River Cities Christian Church provided in-home prayer visits.
- An ADRC (Aging and Disability Resource Center) referral helped her get transportation to the YMCA several times a week.

Today, Jocelyn is walking two miles a day and swimming 15 laps, 2-3 times a week. While she still struggles with her health, she is full of joy. Deb, our Connection Center co-coordinator, shared, "I am not sure who is more blessed when talking with Jocelyn. Her kindness and optimism are contagious, and you can't help but let it rub off on you!" *pseudonym
